Money has been spent to ensure that pupils have the resources to make progress through quality learning experiences and develop an interest or passion for sport. We have focused the development of After School Clubs with greater opportunities to access a wider variety of sports. This has included external providers - ASPIRE, Bugs Group, West Bromwich Foundation, Trompos Cometa, Bangra dancing. Sports covered were netball, fitness, basketball, table tennis and dodgeball. School staff offered sessions including football, girls' football (responding to their request and to give an opportunity to increase their confidence), gymnastics, dance and badminton.

We've allocated and spent money on transport to tournaments. Our commitment to competitive tournaments has been recognised - the school was awarded Sandwell Gold Games mark for the third consecutive year.

Impact

- 2017 2018 a total of 338 pupils across KS1 and 2 attended after school activities this was an increase of 18% from 2016 - 2017
- 2017 2018 increase of 50% of activities offered After School KS1 & 2
- 2017 2018 After School provision KS1 number of activities trebled
