Staff development (Pecs training) this includes classroom monitor (pupil assessment tool)	£4,760 28 weeks	Newly qualified and existing staff are given expert support in effective delivery of physical education. Classroom monitor effectively monitors the quality of PE provision throughout the school.	Classroom monitor shows quantifiable outcomes in pupil progress (bands progress and pupil books) and improved physical skills.
Archery	£1000	Pupils in all year groups to take part in archery sessions. This will provide all pupils with the opportunity to participate in a sport that they would not usually do.	Improved physical skills and leading to quantifiable outcomes in pupil progress.
Bikeability	£1000	Pupils in years 5&6 to complete a bikeability workshop. This will teach pupils how to maintain and ride a bike.	Classroom monitor shows quantifiable outcomes in pupil progress (bands progress and pupil books). Improved physical skills and road safety awareness.
School Games transport costs	£300	Pupils are given the opportunity to partake in the Schools	Improved physical skills and team work skills.

Dance workshop (Stomp)	£950	Pupils are given the opportunity to engage in a dance workshop	Improved physical skills and enjoyment of a new physical activity.
Development of after school sports provision by buying in a specialist sports coach	£245 (7 Week club initially)	To increase after school sports provision to provide the opportunity for more pupils to participate in sporting activities and team sports.	Increased number of pupils engaged in after school sport activities. (This will be measured by attendance record.) Improved physical and social skills which will be measured by Classroom Monitor.)
Contingency	£1,490	To meet identified needs during the school year, including provision of new after school sports clubs. To take advantage of new initiatives that is brought to the schools attention within the academic year.	Increased number of pupils engaged in after school sport activities. Improved physical skills and team work skills.
